Determine the correct Funding Code: Flowchart

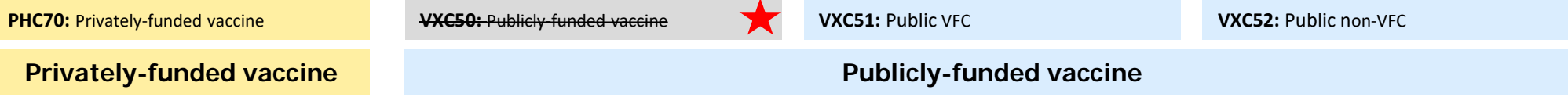
Not all funding codes can be used with each eligibility code (insurance status). Use the diagram below to see what funding codes can be paired with different eligibility codes.
